Founded on the motto *Members helping Members*, the group flourished and in 1993 started its own Internet service, becoming one of the founding suppliers of the Internet in Australia and is still a licensed ISP. MelbPC is Australia's largest and most active personal computer/technology group with thousands of members participating in more than 40 Special Interest Groups (SIGs) that meet regularly throughout Melbourne. The Group is a not-for-profit Incorporated Association and runs on a volunteer basis; an arrangement that has run successfully for three decades.

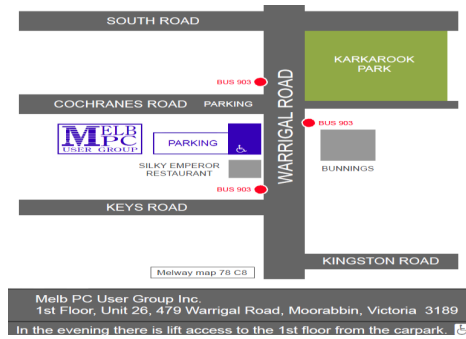
